# BY-LAW No. 179 - 1997

# A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF ITASKA BEACH, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE REGULATION OF THE SMOKING OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS IN MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS.

### WHEREAS:

Section 286 of the Municipal Government Act ('the Act'), being the Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M 26.1 and amendments thereto provides that a Council of a municipality may pass a by By-Law authorizing the regulation of the smoking of tobacco products in municipal buildings.

#### **AND WHEREAS:**

the Council of the Summer Village of Itaska Beach wishes to do so,

#### **NOW THEREFORE:**

the Council of the Summer Village of Itaska Beach in the Province of Alberta hereby enacts as follows:

#### That;

no person shall be permitted to smoke tobacco products of any nature, including but not limited to; cigarettes, pipes and cigars within the confines of a municipal building.

#### OFFENSE

2

- Any person, that is;
  - 1.1 smoking; cigarettes, pipe or cigars or any other flammable tobacco product within a municipal building is in contravention of this Bylaw.

#### **FINES & PENALTIES**

Contravention of this By-Law will result in the following voluntary fines:

- 2.3 Third and Subsequent Offenses......\$100.00

# **PROSECUTION & VOLUNTARY PAYMENTS**

Any person who is in violation of any of the provisions of this By-Law is subject to prosecution in a court of law in the Province of Alberta.

In lieu of prosecution, any person who is alleged to have been in violation of any provision of this By-Law, may voluntarily pay the applicable fine as prescribed in this By-Law in accordance to the terms and conditions of the citation.

Read the second time the 20th day of March 1997.

Read the third time and finally passed the 20th day of March 1997.
